

The focus of the day was on the teaching of reading and writing. I am incredibly pleased to say that the Headteacher's found all lessons to be of a high quality. They commented positively on the quality of the children's writing and their reading ability. It was said that the quality of discussion and vocabulary used in lessons was of a high quality as were the expectations that the teachers set for the children. accessible.




Miss Johnson our Parent Support Advisor, will be hosting coffee morning for parents on Friday 7th July from 9.15– 10.30.
