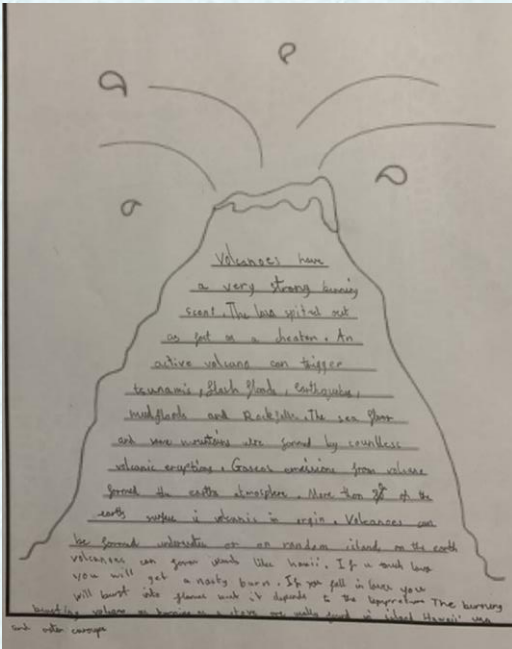


## Wider Curriculum

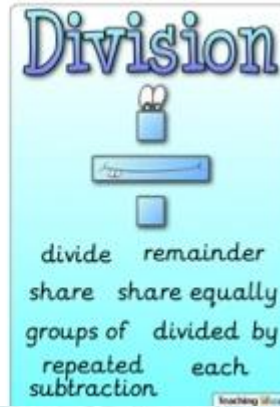
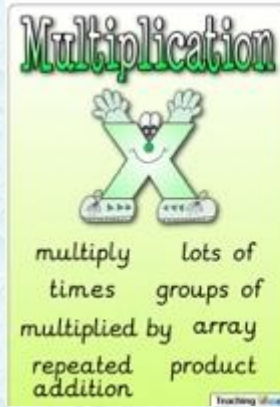
## English

# January

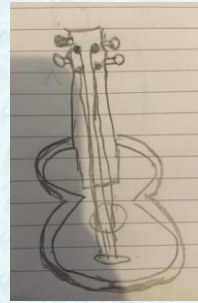
## Maths

We learned about how to use the internet safely.

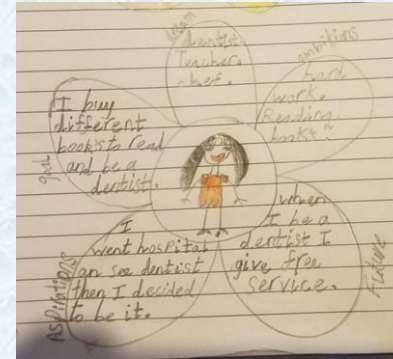


## Music
