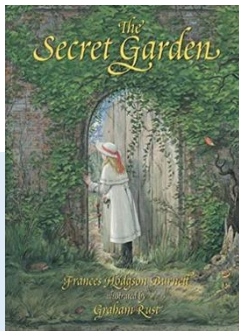
English

Writing:

Text: The Secret Garden

We will be focusing on:

- Improving writing by proof reading and editing
- Using key features of taught genres

- Writing links ideas within and across paragraphs
- Tenses throughout the writing are usually correct
- Who, which, where, when, whose, that, with are used to create relative clauses
- Speech marks generally used correctly to punctuate dialogue



Spellings:

- Words with an/or/ sound spelt 'or' and 'au'
- Convert nouns or adjectives into verbs using the suffix – ate- ise-ify - en

Reading – We teach reading through small group sessions focusing on the National Curriculum targets

Pupils should be taught to:

maintain positive attitudes to reading and understanding of what they read by:

- are structured in different ways and reading for a range of purposes
- increasing their familiarity with a wide range of books, including myths, legends and traditional stories, modern fiction, fiction from our literary heritage, and books from other cultures and traditions
- making comparisons within and across books

understand what they read by:

- checking that the book makes sense to them, discussing their understanding and exploring the meaning of words in context
- asking questions to improve their understanding
- drawing inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence
- predicting what might happen from details stated and implied
- summarising the main ideas drawn from more than one paragraph, identifying key details that support the main ideas
- identifying how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning

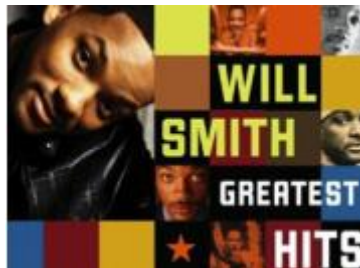
