Pick up time at 3:00pm



In the first week of term a members of staff we will on the gates and playground to show you the way to your child's classroom.

- Year 6– **Blue**

- Royal blue jumper/cardigan/fleece.
- Grey or black skirt, trousers or shorts.
- Summer dress in year group colours.
 - Black shoes. (No Trainers)

- Small stud earrings (no hoops) and no other jewellery unless for religious reasons.

This colour shirt will move up through the year groups with your child. So they will wear a **Green** one now for years 3 then 4, 5 and 6.

Parent Pay/ Parent Mail

- Thames View Juniors is a cash free school. Lunchtimes and Breakfast club are paid for through parent pay.
- If you have a parent pay account with the infants school this cannot be transferred
- New letters with your account information will be given to you in September.
- We also use Parent Pay to collect payment for trips. For each trip you will receive a letter showing you the unique account code which you will then have to use.

- Just like the infant school we use ParentMail to send letters, get permissions for trips, parent's evening booking & clubs.
- In the first week we will be sending out registration texts to get you set up!
